Master thesis – as a rule:

- *as early as possible:* Identify potential supervisors (Information will be distributed)
- *October to December 2019:* Discussions student and supervisor, agreement about topic
- *January 2020:* (form: short description + signature)
- ***January 2020:*** **Submission of the topics proposals by the students**
- *end of January/beginning of February:* approval of the topics by the Examination Committee
- *March 2020:* Start of the master thesis
- *August 2020:* Submission of the thesis
- *September 2020:* Defenses of the project (20 minutes presentation + discussion)

Practical Information: Getting started in Dresden

VISA: How to apply for a Student visa

- Following documents needed:
 - passport valid for the entire period of stay in Germany
 - admission letter from TU Dresden (Zulassungsbescheid)
 - proof of sufficient financial resources
- The initial visa for non-scholarship students is usually issued first for 6 months
- After arrival in Dresden, register at the Dresden City Hall and take an appointment with the Foreigner's Department for extension of visa/residence permit: termin.auslaenderbehoerde@dresden.de
